Digital Photography Guidelines

Digital Photo Requirements;

- Four (4) quality photos must be taken:
 - One (1) of the front view of the flower
 - One (1) of the side view of the flower
 - One (1) of the back view of the flower and
 - One (1) of the full raceme, plant and pot.

In order for an image to be considered for an award the photograph must be witnessed by the Society/Club President, photos are to be a minimum file size of 1.5 megapixels.

- Digital manipulation of an image is prohibited
- No date stamps or text are to be on any images

Hints on better image quality:

- The quality of the image is extremely important in assessing an orchid for an award, where practicable, the use of a tripod is recommended and will assist in providing a sharp image.
- If possible, the orchid should be photographed in daylight using a neutral coloured background and try to fill the frame as much as possible.
- Ensure your camera is set on maximum resolution and quality
